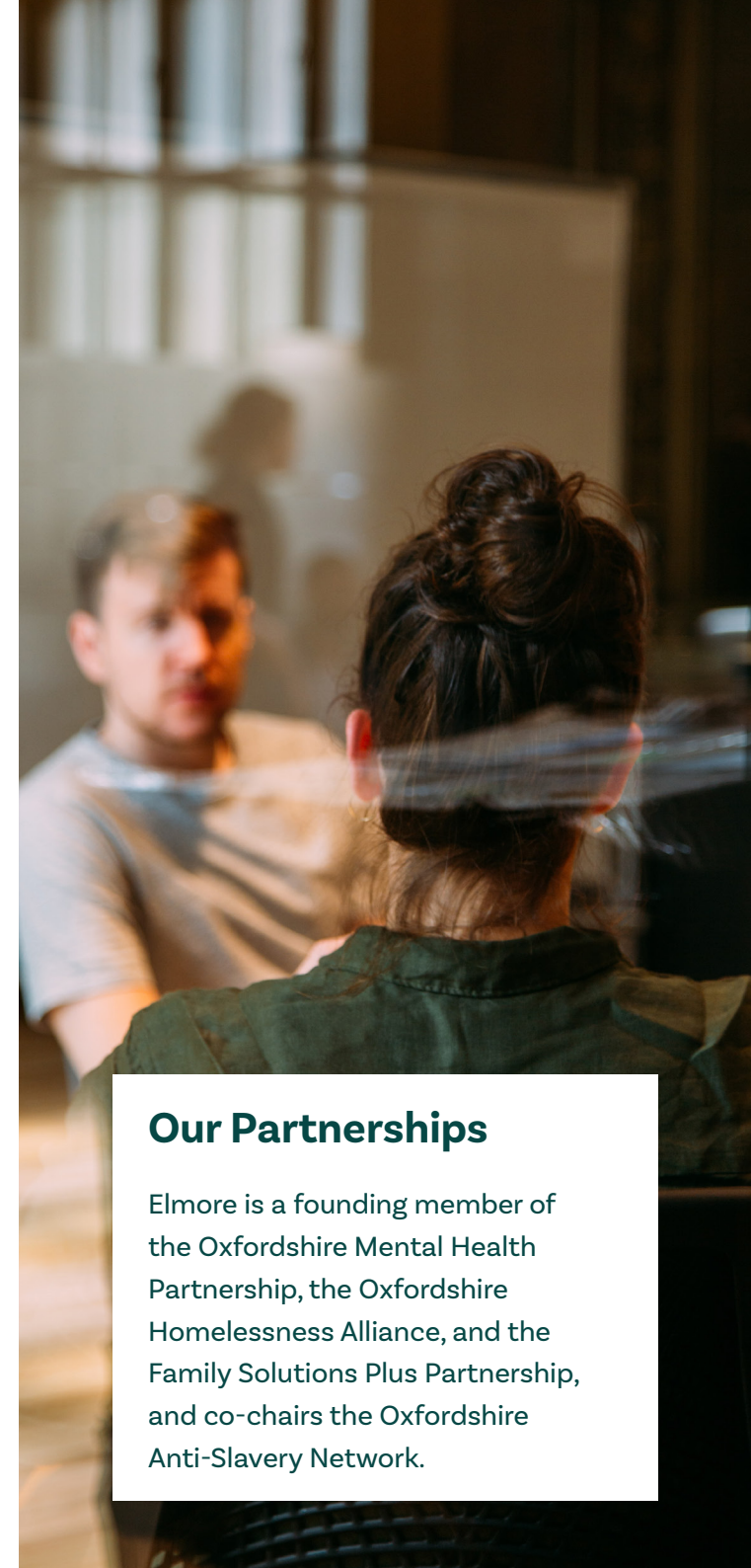
Elmore has received a positive independent evaluation of an Independent Trauma Advisory Service that we piloted for victims of modern-day slavery in Oxfordshire.
